


2.2 Basic Settings






Select "Redlining" and choose an appropriate colour that is easy to see in contrast to the surrounding environment.






To make a make a "Polyline": Click the left mouse button where you would like the line to start. Click left mouse button again, where you would like to set a knee on the line like the line to end. To exit the line, press the right mouse button. It is also possible to choose which type of end you would like to set on the line.

To add a text, there are two different types of texts: "2D" is fixed in space while "3D" rotates together with the model when rotating it. Text properties can be changed and the text can be moved in the same way as a circle and rectangle.





To add a line between the text and the item it should point at, click where you would like the line to point at and drag the line to the text while you're still holding down the mouse button to where the text is located. You can change the shape of the line to an arrow or other appropriate shape.







2.3 Ballooning

To tag characteristics on a drawing to refer to measurement records, use the text, circle and arrow functions to create balloons. Do the following:


- Create the text line
- Create a circle around the text

When you're done, the redlining can be saved in an additional file in format: "I3dxml". When saving, you have to be in "redlining mode" where you can choose between saving changes in either original ".JT"- or ".I3dxml"-file.


